### **Information for parents about international travel**

As part of a safe and cautious reopening to international travel, the UK government's travel lists have been updated. International travel to and from the UK has changed - everyone will need to meet a number of new requirements so we can all travel safely and securely before considering any international journey.

Parents should think carefully about the risks to them, their family, and their community, as well as the impact on their child's education.

To prevent new COVID-19 variants from entering the UK, parents and families should not travel to red list countries.

The school's attendance policy, as agreed by governors, is clear that no leave (whether to travel in England or overseas) during term time will be authorised, whatever the circumstances.

### **Meet your child's teacher meetings**

Working in partnership with parents/carers is very important to us. When school and home work together, outcomes for our pupils are always so much more positive.

Last September, at the start of the new school year, teachers held individual meetings with every parent and, as this was very successful, we are going to do this again w/b 20<sup>th</sup> September. During this meeting the teacher will talk to you about how your child has settled into their new class and what the priorities will be for your child's learning and development.

Next week you will receive a phone call from the school to set up the 1-1 meeting with you and to explain the arrangements.
