ROAD SAFETY AND RESPONSIBLE PARKING!



Every day we now have staff on duty at the Derby Street gate and Waterloo Road gate at the start and end of the school day, ensuring pupils are safe whilst arriving at and leaving the school site.

During this time staff have unfortunately regularly observed the following:

- Parents/carers repeatedly parking on double yellow lines - which is illegal; taxis who are waiting to pick up families from the school are particularly guilty of this
- Parents/carers slowing down their cars right in the middle of the road on Derby Street, slowing down on the double yellow lines, or on the zig zag lines, to pick up their children, instead of parking up
- Parents/carers doing 3-point turns on Derby Street to face the other way, stopping the flow of traffic whilst doing so and in some cases even mounting the pavement when there are pedestrians walking past
- Parents/carers crossing with their children on the bend at the bottom of Waterloo Road and expecting fast and busy traffic to stop for them!

For the safety of the pupils at Cheetwood School, we appeal to all parents/carers to do the following:

- **Please** park responsibly and legally on the roads immediately around the school site, but particularly on Derby Street - and ask anyone else to do the same who may be picking your child up (eg relative or taxi driver)
- **Please** do not stop at any time on the double yellow lines or zig zag lines, even just for a couple of seconds to pick up your child - park up responsibly and legally and pick up that way
- **Please** do not cross on the bend of Waterloo Road - not crossing on a bend is basic road safety! Parents should be teaching their children good road safety habits, so please find a safe place to cross the road
