Travelling Overseas

New laws come into force on Monday 29th March meaning you could face a £5000 fine if you leave the UK and travel overseas. The law says "no one may leave England to travel to a destination outside the UK without a reasonable excuse".

Returning from ANY country abroad also requires a 10 day quarantine period.

School hopes parents would consider these facts very carefully before travelling abroad during the Easter holiday (1st April - 18th April)
