Travelling Overseas

New laws come into force on Monday 29 March meaning you could face a £5000 fine if you leave the UK and travel overseas.

The law says "no one may leave England to travel to a destination outside the UK without a reasonable excuse"

Returning from ANY country abroad also requires a 10 day quarantine period.

School hopes parents would consider these facts very carefully before travelling abroad during the Easter holiday
(1st April - 18th April)

However, if you still do decide to travel overseas, please let us know, so we can advise you on our expectations of home learning and the dates your children can come back to school.
