Yr3: 77%

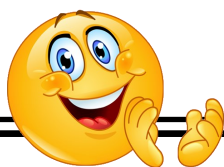
Yr4: 50%

Advice on going abroad over the Christmas holiday

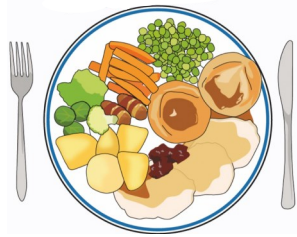
