Year 4 Swimming

Thank you to everyone in Year 4 who made it to school in time for the coach to leave for swimming.

Please ensure your child has a swimming cap, these can be purchased locally at sports direct or easily ordered from amazon. Boys whose hair is long at the front will need to wear a cap from next week.

Some children did not have the correct swimwear. As of next week **they will not be allowed to swim**. These are the suitable costumes and shorts needed for swimming.

Long hair should be tied back and no jewellery.
