A polite reminder that once the school day has finished and parents are on the premises, children **should not** be using any of the bikes/apparatus/ climbing frame in the EYFS playground or the tyres in the main playground.

Staff are allocated to doors, gates and areas to ensure children are leaving safely. Should a child have an accident, it would be very difficult for us to deal with as it's a busy time.

Water Bottles

It's great to see lots of children bringing their water bottles into school, however as we are a healthy school and we can only allow children to have water during the school day (not juice), If your child comes into school with juice in their water bottle they will not be able to drink it until the end of the day. However they can use the water fountains we have around school.

In regards to when children are allowed to drink, they have plenty of opportunities throughout the day. The only time a teacher may tell a child they're not able to is at the beginning of each lesson during the input into what is being taught, which is understandable. Children need to be focused and other children walking around, in and out of the classroom are distractions.
