Cheetwood Community Primary School Year 2: Curriculum News – Autumn Term 1 2023 Class Teacher: Miss Hutchinson Teaching Assistants: Mrs Ahmed and Ms Davies

This half term in Year 2 your child will be learning the following:

<u>English</u> - Areas of Study: 'The Bear and the Piano'- Reading, reading comprehension, guided reading, literacy writing, grammar and punctuation, spellings and speaking and listening

Writing outcomes:

- Reading and responding
- Sequencing events
- Joining sentences using <u>and</u>, <u>but</u> and <u>because</u>
- Using expanded noun phrases to describe
- Writing a letter of advice
- Narrative writing

How you can support your child:

- Encourage your child to read a range of stories with different settings.
- Discuss with your child the features of fiction and non-fiction texts.
- Listen to your child read a variety of texts at home including poetry, newspapers and magazines and ask them questions about what they have read.
- Encourage your child to create their own stories or tell you a story that they know.
- Encourage your child to talk about their books and complete book activities such as book reviews and character descriptions.
- Test your child on their half termly spellings and their definitions.

To help your child to improve their reading, encourage them to read at least three times a week and get their reading record signed each time.

Maths - Areas of Study – The maths curriculum covers number and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

How you can support your child

- Practise mental maths skills at home regularly, particularly times tables. The children will be tested on their knowledge of times tables.
- Encourage your child to use Maths in everyday life. For example, counting out money, reading bus or television timetables, sharing out treats equally or weighing out ingredients.
- Help them to complete their Maths homework.
- Practise their number bonds to 10, 20 and 100

Science - Areas of Study: Growth and Survival

- To find out about the offspring of a variety of different animals.
- To find out about the different ways in which animals reproduce.
- To explore how humans grow as they get older.
- To find out what animals, including humans, need to survive.
- To explore the environment as a factor of survival for animals, including humans.
- To find out how to eat a healthy, balanced diet.
- To find out why exercise is important to keep our bodies healthy

How you can support your child:

- Talk about how different animals produce babies (birth or eggs)
- Talk about what happens to humans as they get older (from babies to adults)
- Research what animals including humans need to survive
- Discuss how the environment can affect an animals survival
- Research and create a healthy, balanced diet
- Find out about why exercise is important to keep people healthy

Geography – Area of Study: At the farm

- Explore what farms are and why they are important.
- Explore the features of a farm.
- Use a map and symbols to navigate around a farm.
- Explore how the seasons affect life on a farm.
- Explore the differences between life on a farm and life in a town.

How you can support your child:

- Research any of the above areas of study
- Discuss what a farm is and what animals are on farms
- Discuss what farm do to help people and communities
- Find out about the different types of farm in England
- Look at picture of farms and animals

Design Technology – Area of study: Textiles – pouches

• Sew a running stitch

- Thread a needle
- Use neat and evenly spaced stitches to join fabric
- Cut fabric neatly
- Pin fabric accurately
- Design a pouch
- Sew neat, even stitches
- Design decorations for my product
- Join items using fabric glue or stitching
- Decorate fabric using different items
- Evaluate my own designs
