It is everyone's responsibility to uphold the welfare of every child and ensure they come to no harm.

The school has four trained Designated Safeguarding Leads for Child Protection:

The governor with responsibility for safeguarding is QUDSIA SALEEM

Any member of staff (permanent, temporary or supply), governor, student on placement, volunteer worker or visitor to the school who has a child protection concern <u>must report their concern to a designated safeguarding lead.</u>

Without exception, you will be asked to record your concern in writing either on the school's child protection concern form or on CPOMS (for staff who have access).

The designated safeguarding lead will then decide on the next course of action, in consultation with the other designated persons.

The school's Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy is reviewed annually and a copy is stored in the electronic folder named "Policies" saved on the Teaching and Learning drive of the school network.

There is a further electronic folder saved on the Teaching and Learning drive of the school network called "Safeguarding" which contains electronic copies of a range of relevant documents:

- Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy
- Whistle Blowing Policy
- o Guidance on how to make a multi agency referral
- Manchester Safeguarding Partners procedures
- o DfE safeguarding guidance
