Your child must be in Years 4, 5,6 or 7. Children on Free School Meals will be prioritised. Registration is via a Microsoft form – please scan the QR code below.

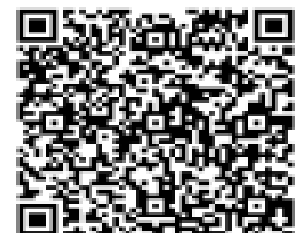
