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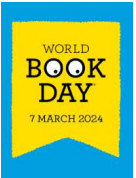

* We raised **£107.70 for NSPCC** during last week's Number Day! Thank you!



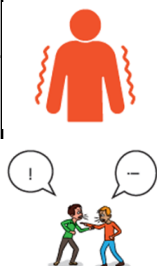
Cheetwood's Article of the Week!
