Theme: Life cycles

Children will learn about life cycles and habitats. Children will be introduced to key features and characteristics and develop their vocabulary to compare similarities and differences.

Words to learn this half term:

Leaves, rock, log, grass, flowers, spiderling, spider, ladybird, worm, wood lice, damp, dark, summer, sun, hot, warm, egg, duckling, duck, hatch, pond

We will be using all of our senses to explore some exciting activities such as: cooking, planting, drama, and arts and crafts

Visits

This half term we will be having a visit from our school care taker who will be helping the nursery children to create an outdoor bug hotel!

Maths

This half term we will be continuing to look at the language used to describe shapes. We are going to be making lots of models such as bug hunting devices, binoculars and spiders using junk modelling materials. We will be discussing what shapes we need and what would work best as we create!

We will be continuing to practise counting to 10 and identifying one more/ one less than a number to 5. We will also be comparing amounts and identifying which has more or fewer objects.

Please use the words - round, straight, edges, corners, tall, short, curved, pointy, square, triangle, rectangle, circle, cylinders, spheres, cubes, cuboid, in, out, in front, behind, under, and on.
