Cheetwood Community Primary School Year 2: Curriculum News – Summer Term 1 2024

This half term in Year 2 your child will be learning the following:

English – Areas of Study: Phonics, reading comprehension, guided reading, literacy writing, grammar and punctuation, spellings and speaking and listening.

Key texts studied: Jim and the Beanstalk - Raymond Briggs and Three Cheers for Inventors by Marcia Williams

Writing outcomes include:

- Reading and responding
- Sequencing events
- Asking questions and discussion
- Descriptive writing
- Using speech marks
- Role-play
- Report writing

How you can support your child:

- Encourage your child to read a range of fiction stories and think about who their favourite author is and why they like their books.
- Discuss with your child the features of fiction and non-fiction texts.
- Listen to your child read a variety of texts at home including poetry, newspapers and magazines and ask them questions about what they have read.
- Encourage your child to create their own stories or tell you a story that they know.
- Encourage your child to talk about their books and complete book activities such as book reviews and character descriptions.
- Test your child on their half termly spellings and their definitions.

To help your child to improve their reading, encourage them to read at least three times a week and get their reading record signed each time. Go through any test papers you child brings home.

Maths - Areas of Study - The maths curriculum covers fractions, time, statistics and position & direction & time

How you can support your child:

- Practise mental maths skills at home regularly, particularly times tables. The children will be tested on their knowledge of times tables.
- Encourage your child to use maths in everyday life. For example, counting out money, reading bus or television timetables, sharing out treats equally or weighing out ingredients.
- Help them to complete their maths homework.
- Practise counting on and back in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Go through any test papers you child brings home.
