In Y6 this half term your child will be learning the following:

English

Areas of Study: Reading, reading comprehension, whole class reading, writing – using ‘Suffragette: the battle for equality’ as our stimulus, grammar and punctuation, Y6 spellings and speaking and listening

Class Read – Macbeth by Shakespeare, Grimm Tales for Young & Old by Philip Pullman

How you can support your child:

- Practise the SATS style questions in the CGP books, daily, remembering to take regular breaks.
- Encourage your child to read a range of texts such as newspapers, leaflets, stories and to record their reading/thoughts in their reading records.
- Talk to your child about their reading book and complete book activities such as book reviews and character descriptions
- Encourage your child to do independent writing such as story writing, recounts and descriptions
- Test your child on their half termly spellings
- Encourage and practice neat, legible and cursive handwriting.

Maths

Areas of Study: Ratio & proportion, algebra, fractions/decimals/percentages, area/perimeter/volume and statistics

How you can support your child:

- Practise the SATS style questions in the CGP books, daily, remembering to take regular breaks.
- Practise mental maths skills at home regularly, particularly times tables and division facts
- Place value practice – multiplying and dividing by 10, 100, 1000 and beyond.
- Practise any areas your child is struggling with
- Go through homework
- Practice arithmetic daily

Science – Evolution & Inheritance

- Learning things produce offspring of the same kind and rare not identical to their parents.

How you can support your child:

- Research the above areas of study with your child

Geography – North America

- Counties in North America
- Climates
- Geographical features
- Capital Cities
- Time Zones
- Comparing to a UK region
- Human and Physical Geography

D&T

Textiles – Making a waistcoat

- To consider a range of factors in their design criteria and use this to create a waistcoat design.
- To use a template to mark and cut out a design.
- To use a running stitch to join fabric to make a functional waistcoat.
- To attach a secure fastening, as well as decorative objects.
- To evaluate their final product.

PSHE

Relationships Education

As part of our P.S.H.E curriculum, this half term your child will be taught about ‘Relationships’ covering:

- Different Relationships
- Unwanted touch
- What is FGM?
- What is puberty?

Parents are not able to withdraw their child from ‘Relationships Education’.

The sessions in school may reinforce what you are already speaking to your child about at home and the key words below may assist you with these conversations.

For some of the more sensitive topics in Relationships Education, boys and girls will be taught separately.

Key Vocabulary

Truthfulness, trustworthiness, loyalty, kindness, generosity, trust, pressure, Marriage, civil partnerships, forced/arranged, Consent, Mental health, consent, committed relationship, responsibility. Transition, independence. Legal, illegal, choice, Female genital mutilation (FGM), menstruation time, vagina, penis, testicles, breasts, vulva

Plus, revisiting the Key Vocabulary from the previous year.

PE

Pupils will be doing PE on the following day: **TUESDAY & FRIDAY**

Please send your child in full PE kit on this day. They do not need to wear school uniform

As pupils are not permitted to wear any jewellery for PE, it helps if earrings and other jewellery are not worn to school on the day we do PE.

Homework

Homework will be given out 3x during the week, this could be research based, paper copies or written.

In addition, each week your child will be given:

- A piece of reading homework given out on Friday
- Half termly spellings to be learnt for weekly tests.
